Code of Conduct

Students enrol in the Dteq programs at North Metropolitan TAFE in order to learn. Students are required to accept the following conditions:

- Have a sense of self responsibility about your study program.
- Treat staff and fellow students courteously and with consideration at all times.
- Abusive, violent and/or dangerous behaviour which threatens or disrupts other people is not allowed.
- Maintain a reasonable standard of grooming, including appropriate standards of hygiene and clothing.
- Take reasonable care of North Metropolitan TAFE property, equipment, and facilities
- Observe all OHS rules.
- Smoking is prohibited on Central property.
- Drugs and alcohol are not permitted on Central property.
- Eating and drinking are not permitted in all classrooms and libraries. Your supervisor may allow water bottles in some areas of the classroom.
- Mobile phones must be turned off in all classrooms and libraries.
- Computers are to be used appropriately.
- Cheating and other academic misconduct is not acceptable.
- Sexual harassment is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
